LAST MEETING MINUTES

Cabarrus Quilters Guild
Minutes of General Membership Meeting
Monday, October 8, 2018

Past President Connie Richardson opened the meeting at 6:30 due to an officer's retreat. She welcomed all present and began the meeting by asking for an approval of the September minutes printed in the newsletter. The minutes were approved after motions made and a vote taken. Natalie Swilley announced several visitors and Connie read October birthdays from the newsletter and a reminder will be given in November for members with October birthdays to pick out a fat quarter. She said Quilt show results will be presented in November and asked Julie Love to speak about the 2019 quilt show. Julie said a new location was needed as CFA is remodeling and the site will not be available next year. Julie asked everyone to use the paper on each table to write comments and suggestions for the quilt show. Pat Stedwell spoke to members about the guild's B.J membership that renews in November and asked new members to see her for brochures and for

current members to confirm renewal. Pat said 8 members are now enrolled for \$30 vs. \$55 for individual membership. Darlene Woodham said the Intro to Paper Piecing workshop with Gail Toliver tomorrow has some openings available. CVAN quilts will be shown at the November meeting and December will be our Christmas party. No other workshops are scheduled until March, 2019 with Ann P. Shaw's Collage workshop that was cancelled this year due to weather. Ann comes from Washington State and other area guild members will be invited.

Darlene introduced Tammy Blandon from Christian Tours who gave a brief history of the company and asked members who attended the Missouri Star Tour to share their experience. She then described the upcoming Houston International Quilt Festival Tour and showed pictures of the tour stops. The tour will be 8 days from October 29th to November 5, 2019 and deposits for early booking discount (\$40) are due by next Monday if not paid tonight. Tammy drew names for prizes and she will take application forms during the break.

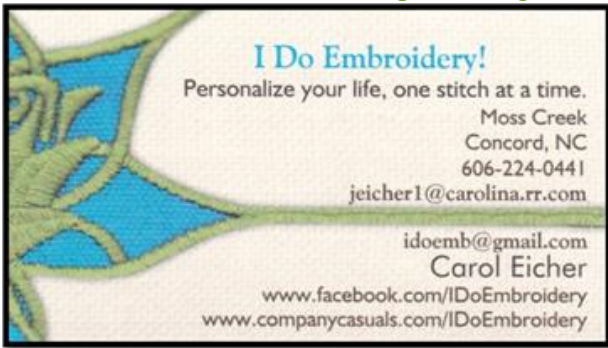
Paid members receive the newsletter by email. For US mail, there is a \$10.00 charge to defray the cost of paper and postage. It will also be available on the guild website for everyone.

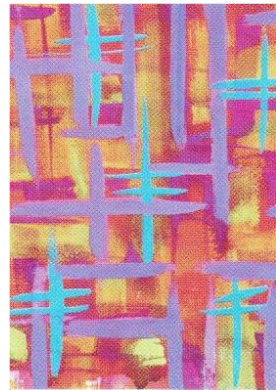
