The workshop will be on Tuesday February 14th from 10am to 4pm in the Widenhouse building at Epworth UMC. The cost is \$45, there is no kit fee. Lyric Kinard will be the guest speaker in March, her lecture will be on Surface design, the workshop is Surface Design Sampler Platter. Lyric says "it's a full day of playing with all sorts of fun stuff like stamp carving, foiling, screen printing, and even bead work". The workshop will be on Tuesday March 13th from 10am to 4pm also in the Widenhouse building at Epworth UMC. The cost is \$45 with an additional \$10 fee for class materials.
